

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION

Adopting a Publication Scheme is a requirement of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This Act promotes greater openness and accountability across the public sector by requiring all "Public Authorities" to make information available proactively, through a Publication Scheme.

The main groups or classes of information available in the model publication scheme are:

1. GOVERNANCE
2. FINANCIAL RESOURCES
3. HUMAN RESOURCES
4. PHYSICAL RESOURCES
5. STUDENT ADMINISTRATION AND SUPPORT
6. INFORMATION SERVICES
7. TEACHING AND LEARNING
8. EXTERNAL RELATIONS
